For our remote team building packages, we are offering two options for 1 hour interactive team entertainment on Zoom (or your preferred team platform). One hour of simply letting loose and having a laugh together, with the option of a post show facilitation with more direct outcomes.

### TEAM BUILDING IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE...

Even though different people work differently, teams thrive on collaboration, contact, idea sharing and seeing different perspectives. Not having daily contact comes at a cost where problem solving can't happen quickly because relationships suffer when we don't have face to face contact time.

Team building opens the gate for accessibility, teams getting to know one another better and creating relationships that encourage approachability. Team Building can show our colleagues in a different context- a personal one that is great for relationship building-which, in turn, helps teams recognise one another's skill sets, manage and embrace change as well as find coping mechanisms in themselves and each another.






















# ZOOMPROV

# J.BOBS LIVE


Looking for something a bit more interactive?

Together they have had audiences banging down the door to attend, participate and let their inner competitor revel in a mash up of theatre, improv, sketch and game show all very cleverly compiled by the show's writers to offer insight into uniquely South African realities. # PRICING, TERMS & CONDITIONS

The standard cost for a 1 hour show is R 20 000 ex VAT (including an HR consult before the date of the team build)

- Branded team invites are optional at no extra cost.
- Technical requirements to be discussed between our tech team and yours. While we mainly work on Zoom, we have various options depending on the size of the group or your preferred team meeting platform.
- Specifically designed content (for particular team/ HR outcomes) is available at an additional fee of R 5000 ex VAT.
- A post show facilitation is available at an additional cost, to be discussed.

These offerings are also available at your office / in real life provided strict Covid-19 protocol is followed.

### **FOR BOOKINGS:**

- A minimum of 5 working days notice are required to book the venue and personnel.
- For company's agendas and objectives to be incorporated into the workshops, a brief is required a minimum of 2 days prior to the workshop.
- A 50% deposit is required to book the date, with the balance of the payment due no later than the day before the workshops.

# COMMUNICATION, LEADERSHIP AND CHANGE MANAGEMENT FACILITATION

### WHY USE THEATRE & PERFORMING ART SKILLS FOR TRAINING & FACILITATION?

The basics of the craft of acting include training in excellent communication as well as understanding human nature. The skills that an actor uses for their every day work, can quite easily be applied to challenges in the workplace. We work with industrial psychologists to design and facilitate training programs and interventions to suit a team's needs and budget.

Useful performance skills that can be applied to the workplace include:

**LISTENING**: Developing a skill of listening to verbal and non verbal communication from others.

**RESPONDING:** 'Acting is Reacting', training that assists with appropriate response to verbal and non verbal communication from others, as well as taking in and responding to changes in the environment.

**COLLABORATION AND TEAM WORK:** The success of an actors work hinges entirely on how they work with their team mates on stage.

**EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION:** Basic skills to get your message across. The job of the actor is to deliver a message to an audience.

**EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION:** Basic skills and techniques for better delivery and presentation- from making the most of your vocal apparatus to dealing with performance/ presentation anxiety.

**PARTICIPATION:** All of our workshop packages will require participation from team members.

**LETTING GO:** Acting teaches us to let go, have fun and enjoy the moment.
