





HISTORY



SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAMME



Designed to boost confidence, creativity, and social skills, the program provides a safe, fun environment where kids can learn, make friends, and enjoy their holiday.



The holiday programme will run from 5 December - 12 December as follows:

5, 6, 7 & 9 December : Ages 4 - 8 years, 9am - 12:30pm 10, 11, 12 & 13 December : Ages 9 - 13 years, 9am - 2pm (*0NLY 25 spots per age group)

Each day will feature a new arts session (or two). At the end of each day, a small (no pressure!) presentation / exhibition will be prepared and shown to the parents in the last 30mins of each day. (Parents are welcome in the room throughout)




WHAT

- Alternative creative expression




WHAT

 physical activity for children of all abilities




- Children stay active during the holidays.






Hi there! I'm Modi!

He is very athletic and a big time sports fan.




Aalliyah Matintela







Samukelisiwe Khuzwayo




Hayleigh Evans







Anganati Kupiso
